On their PE and Games days, children need to come to school wearing their PE kit.

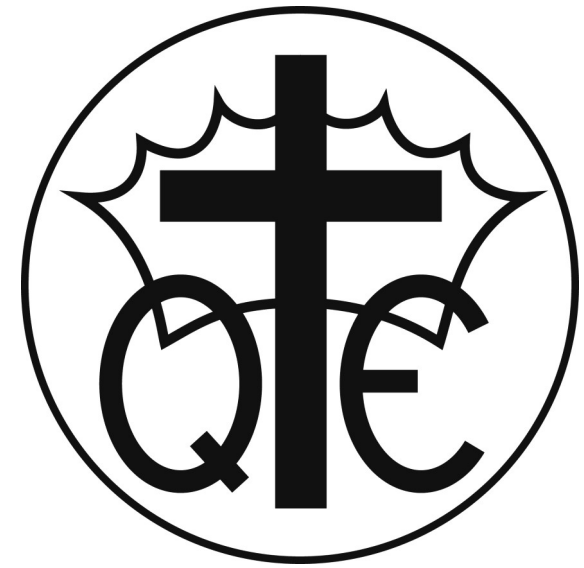
Children may wear a plain tracksuit (black or blue) for outside Games during winter and a change of socks with their PE kit.
