Swimming kits are to be brought in on Monday and taken home on Friday every week (as the pool is weather dependent).

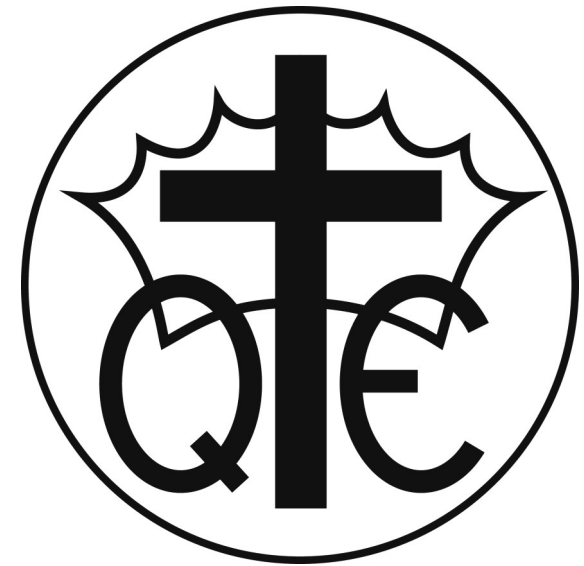
READING
