Home School Agreement

AIMS AND VALUES

At Queen Eleanor's we aim to get the best out of all children socially, personally and academically, within a fun, caring environment guided by Christian values, thereby instilling a lifelong love of learning.

CURRICULUM

The School will:

- ensure that every child is taught at an appropriate and challenging level by qualified teachers;
- maintain an attractive environment with good materials and equipment and teach the full National Curriculum and religious education;
- provide swimming tuition from Year 3 to Year 6.

BEHAVIOUR

The School will:

- make sure children are familiar with school rules;
- use rewards and sanctions fairly;
- make sure that school staff always set a high standard of personal behaviour;
- respect the views of children and parents, acknowledging the different circumstances that exist;
- Keep you informed about the school's policies and guidelines on behaviour

EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES

The School will:

- try to enable all children to take part in all activities;
- celebrate the diverse backgrounds that we come from;
- where possible use different cultural examples in teaching;
- ensure that bullying and racist, sexist and other discriminating behaviour is not tolerated.

HOMEWORK

The School will:

- set appropriate homework regularly and ensure that it is marked.

ATTENDANCE & PUNCTUALITY

The School will:

- ensure classes start promptly at 9.00am;
- maintain an accurate record of attendance.

I will:

- encourage my child to participate fully in school activities;
- support my child's learning at school by attending parents' meetings and performances;
- encourage my child to practise music at home;
- provide my child with suitable clothing for school activities.

I will:

- help my child understand and follow the school rules;
- encourage my child to care for school property both at school and at home;
- behave in a way that sets children a good example when I am on school premises.

I will:

- help my child understand that everyone is of equal importance;
- encourage my child to appreciate and respect the views and religions of others.

I will:

- help my child return homework on time;
- help my child find a quiet place and time to do homework;
- ensure school property is looked after when at home;
- read to and with my child frequently.

I will:

- make sure that my child is at school regularly and on time;
- make sure that my child is collected on time;
- contact the school promptly when my child is absent;
- avoid taking holidays in term time (and understand that this may result in a Fixed Penalty Notice as set out in the School's Attendance policy);
- try, where possible, to book medical and dental appointments outside of the school day.

WELFARE AND COMMUNICATION

The School will:

- ensure that children are safe on school premises and on school trips;
- administer medicines only with written permission
- give full and clear information about the curriculum, and each child's progress, standard achieved and development needs;
- communicate frequently with parents about school matters and set dates for events early and inform parents.

Pupils

I agree to:

- Always try to do my best in my lessons.
- Always try to remember to be polite and thoughtful towards others.
- Always try to enjoy school and help other children do the same.

I will:

- teach my child about personal hygiene;
- make sure the school always has an up-to-date emergency contact number;
- keep my child at home when unwell; to raise any concerns with the appropriate person as early as possible;
- let the school know of issues that may affect my child's welfare or progress at school.
